NATIONAL HOSPITAL DELIVERS THREE TEST-TUBE BABIES IN ONE WEEK

The National Hospital, Abuja has delivered three test-tube babies between 3rd and 10th April, 2007.

On 3rd April, 2007 a male baby weighing 2.65 Kg was delivered at about 10.41 a.m.

Two babies (Male and Female) weighing 3.35Kg and 3.1 Kg respectively were delivered on 10th April, 2007 by two different mothers. All the babies were born by caesarian section.

The one delivered on 3rd April, 2007 was discharged on 10th April. The two delivered on the same day are still in stable conditions in the Hospital.

It can be recalled that before now the first test-tube baby in a government owned Hospitals was delivered on 8th March 2007 in National Hospital.

All the four test-tube babies born so far in the Hospital and their mothers are in stable health conditions.
